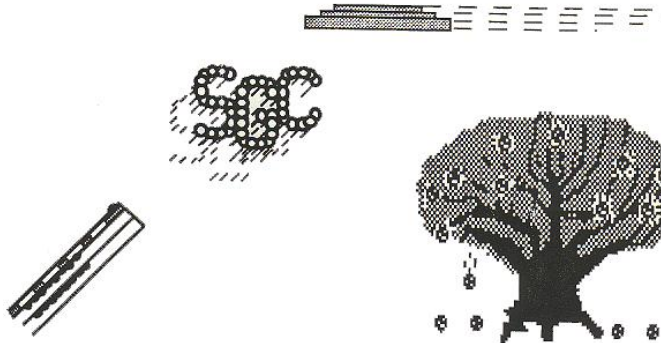
**AMMUNITION:** Hand loads in accordance with
